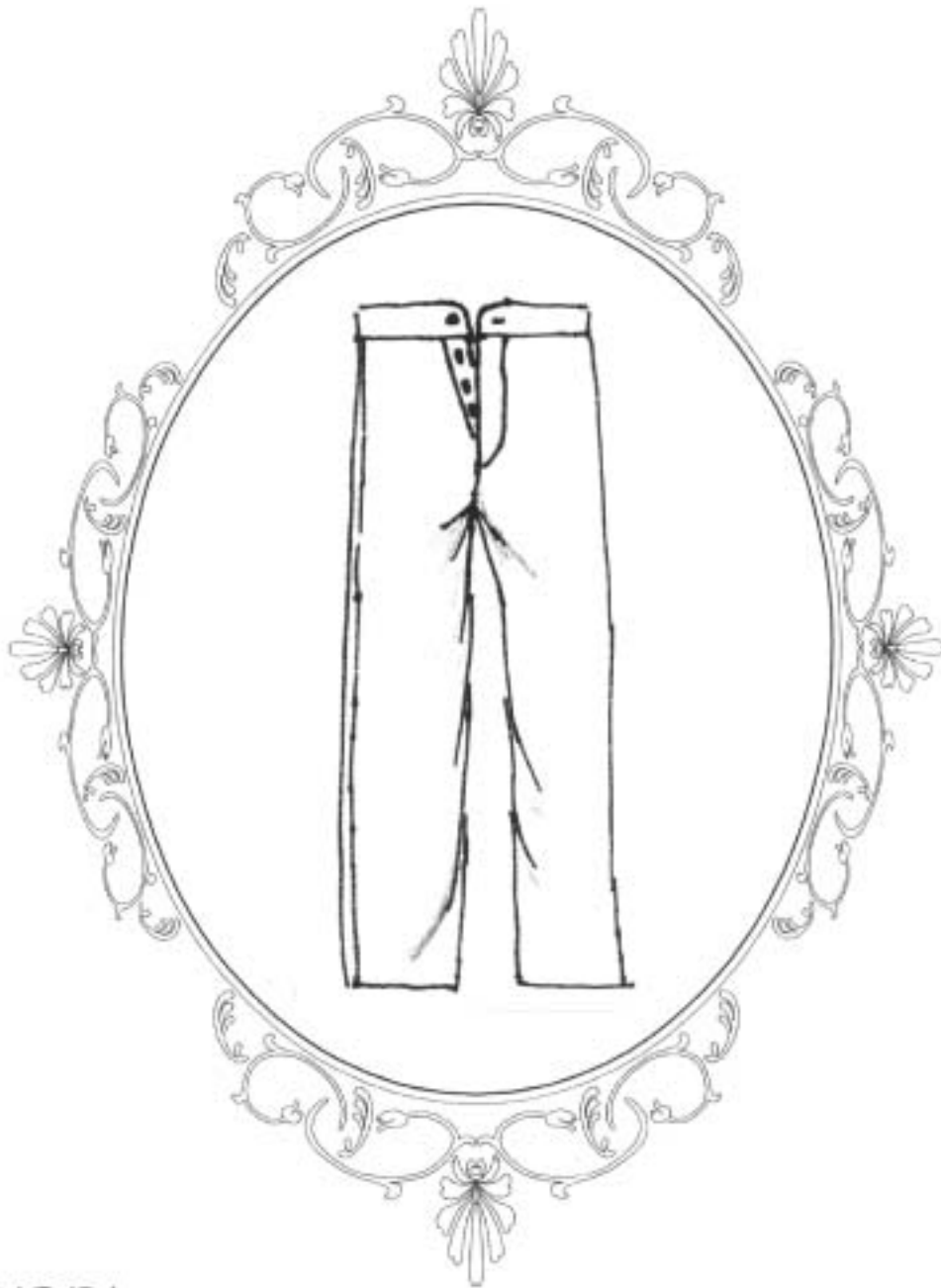

Mid 19th Century Civilian Trousers

TSM-727

This pattern is for civilian style trousers that could have been worn after about 1840. It was around this time that the use of a front flap was discontinued in favor of a button fly. The pattern includes three styles of pocket opening: side (slash) pockets, a mule-ear style and a modified slash pocket. The pattern includes a choice of hemlines for the front of the trouser; the curved line being designed to curve over the front of the boot and being more tailored than the straight line. Tips for handling wool are also included.

Fabric Requirements:

2 yds of 60" fabric for 34 – 42 waists

2 ½ to 3 yds 60 " fabric for 44 – 52 waists

3 ½ yds for X-Large sizes

¾ yd of duck, twill or heavy muslin for pockets and lining.

5 buttons for the fly front

Sizing: Use your largest circumference of stomach to choose the size desired, by comparing the waist measurements.

To aid the seamstress this pattern is sized to the waist measurement
